



2026 Jackson/Nemaha Bullmasters' Shooting Sports State Qualifier

BB Gun, Air Rifle, and Air Pistol

The Jackson/Nemaha Bullmasters will be hosting a shooting sports match for BB Gun, Air Rifle and Air Pistol. This match is a state qualifier. All levels of shooters are invited to participate from 4-H age 8 to 18.

NOTE: the minimum age to participate at the State Match is 9 years old by Jan. 1, 2026.

Registration forms and fees are due by Friday, February 22. Late registrations only accepted to fill relays. Fees are \$15 per shooter per discipline. Air rifle will be limited to the first 54 shooters. Air pistol will be limited to the first 36 shooters. We will only accept registration from one person per county and this person will be notified of relay times. Registration will begin at 7:00 a.m. **Each county needs to verify their shooters' information when checking in for correct age and disciplines, no changes will be made after registration.**

BB Gun: Shooters will shoot 10 shots in each of the 4 positions. Rules will follow the latest edition of the NRA BB Gun Rules, the 2026 Kansas State Spring Match Rules & Daisy National BB Gun Match rules. Individual awards will be given to the top 3 shooters in each division, 8 year old, Junior & Senior, for position and aggregate. Age breaks to be determined. Orion will determine the teams; team awards will be given to the top 3 teams overall. To qualify for the State Match in BB gun, the minimum individual score is **335** out of a possible 400.

Air Rifle: Shooters will shoot 20 shots in each of the 3 positions. Rules will follow the current CMP National Standard 3-position Air Rifle rulebook & the 2026 Kansas State Spring Match Rules. Either clear chamber indicators or clear bore indicators must be used. Only .177 flat-nose wadcutter pellets will be allowed. We will follow the ISSF format of kneeling, prone, standing. Individual awards will be given per position and aggregate to the top 3 shooters in each division, Juniors 13 & under, Senior 14 & up. Teams will be selected by Orion & awards will be given to the top 3 teams. To qualify for the State Match in air rifle, the minimum individual score is **450** out of 600.

Air Pistol: Shooters will shoot 40 shots at 2 targets with 4 bulls (five shots per bull) in two segments. Rules will follow the current USAS-NRA Air Pistol rulebook & the 2026 Kansas State Spring Match Rules. All air pistol shooters must have a current signed handgun permission form on their firing line with them. These will be checked by the range officer. Juniors 10-13 will shoot one or two handed unsupported. Seniors age 14-18 will shoot one handed unsupported. Sighting shots will be allowed only in Segment 1. Only .177 flat-nose wadcutter pellets are allowed. Individual awards will be given to the top 3 shooters in each age division. Teams will be selected by Orion; team awards will be given to the top 3 teams overall (Junior & Senior shooters). To qualify for the State Match in air pistol, the minimum individual score is **280** out of a possible 400.
